Journey and building are the two images that explain our lives. We journey through this life from birth to death, from our first to our last step, from our first to our last breath. While on our journey through life we are building. As kids we built with blocks or Legos or models. As adolescents we begin to build our identity, figuring out who we are, where we belong, and what gifts and skills we possess. Entering adulthood, we begin putting the pieces of our lives together – education, work, family, friends, hobbies. Approaching the final years of life we begin to look back on our life's journey and what we've built and ask, "Was the journey worth it? Did I build what mattered?"



At Cornerstone Church we are on a Kingdom Journey, building for the generations. We took our first breath when in the late 1800's, four families who migrated from Wisconsin to the Watertown area began meeting with a pastor in their homes, which led to Pastor Young holding mission tent meetings on the corner of 4th St. and 2nd Ave NE, which led to the formation of a Sunday School in 1911 with 15 people. On their journey to help people find their spiritual home in Jesus Christ, they built their first church building in 1913 at 409 North Maple. As their journey continued and the church grew, in 1955 they purchased lots on the corner of 9th Ave. and 3rd St NE, completing construction of a new church in 1958. As their journey continued and the church grew as they helped people find their spiritual home in Jesus Christ, we bought our current location in 1997 and built our current facility for \$2.5 million, marching over on a Sunday morning from our 9th Avenue location to our current building in 2002.

Now, in 2025, as we are reaching and helping more and more kids, youth, and adults to find their spiritual home in Jesus Christ, it's time to build for the generations to come! We need more lobby space, rooms for adult Sunday School classes, adequate bathrooms for men, women, and families, and eventually a worship space for the Traditional Worship Service. Thank you for being part of this great Kingdom of God journey we're on together in which we build facilities to help us welcome people to find their spiritual home in Jesus Christ. More information and details to come in September and October. In the meantime, thank God that he is using us to help people find their spiritual home in Jesus, and get ready to join together to build, not just for the generations already here, but for the generations to come! AGE: 0-3 YEARS OLD

We provide a clean and safe environment located just down the hall from the Worship Center. The Nursery is staffed during the 9:30am & 10:45am services. Parents, you can feel comfortable leaving your child in the loving care of our Nursery team of volunteers as you enjoy worship and the message.

THE WEE ARK

AGE: 3 YEARS OLD

(must be 3 years old by September 1st) **EXPLORE FAITH** with a walk through The Word. In the Old Testament, your wee little one will be introduced to God's power and loving character & in the New Testament guided to a personal friendship with Jesus. SING • PRAY • CARPET TIME • TABLE TIME 3-year-olds who begin in this room, stay in this room for the remainder of the year. If your 3-year-old is not ready for this step, the Nursery is still available for them until they are comfortable.

THE LITTLE ARK

AGE: 4 YEARS OLD - KINDERGARTEN

(must be 4 years old by September 1st)

EMBRACE FAITH in The Little Ark! Your child will experience a large and small group setting. The Bible stories, prayer time, worship, crafts, and games aim to help them understand that "God made me", "God loves me", and "Jesus wants to be my friend forever."

THE ARK

AGE: 1ST - 4TH GRADE

ENGAGE IN FAITH through worship, interactive games & activities, word knowledge, prayer, and Bible stories. The teachings are driven to help kids grow in virtue knowing that "I can trust God no matter what", "I need to make a wise choice", and "I need to treat others the way I want to be treated."

THE ARK.56

AGE: 5TH & 6TH GRADE

ENJOY (OWN) YOUR FAITH knowing you are not too young....." to be an example to all believers in what you say, in the way you live, in your love, in your faith, in your purity." 1 Timothy 4:12. Preteens will have their own space to continue building a faith foundation as they hear God's Word, learn life application skills, form relationships, ask questions, play games, and worship.


