STEPPING INTO 2026





SINGING SONGS IS LIKE SLINGING STONES

Psalms 144:1-2

"The Lord, my protector, deserves praise – the one who trains my hands for battle, and my fingers for war, who loves me and is my stronghold, my refuge and my deliverer, my shield and the one in whom I take shelter, who makes nations submit to me."


When we come to church to worship together, we enter a space to join with all of heaven, all of creation and the entire body of Christ to magnify God. The sound of worship expressed by God's people emanates from the very breath we sing out this breath which was given to us by God to sustain our very life.

Every week we face down the enemy of our souls and the opposition to the work of God in the world. God gave us a song to sing to repel the voice and influence of the enemy. Dan Wilt, author, pastor, & worship leader writes about the place that songs hold in our worship. This excerpt is adapted from his book, "Songs are a Place We Go":

"When a giant needed to be dealt with, God sent a musician. David, the young shepherd who faced down the giant Goliath was a musician. While tending to his father's flocks in his lonely life as a shepherd, he had not only learned how to sling stones at lions and bears; he learned how to face down the enemy in his own heart through the singing of songs.

Music has played a powerful role in enabling small heroes to take down big enemies. God sends a musician to help people face their giants every week. And the music, sound, & visuals that support those songs deliver anthems into people's hearts that are needed for their battle lines.

Songs are as sure to turn the tide in a battle as the five smooth stones David pulled from the stream. Every giant in the room on a Sunday morning has been served notice when the people of God begin to sing, fear has met its match."



What's one giant that you are facing right now? How can a song strengthen your heart to trust in God's promises? Name a song that has been a powerful weapon a stone in your sling against the enemy of your soul and play that song as you take some time to worship God with the breath that God has given you. Remember, God gave you a voice to praise Him with, and he gives you songs only you can sing.




Cornerstone will be hosting a support group called Grief Share, a Christ-centered teaching that focuses on grief topics associated with the death of a loved one.

KINGDOM JOURNEY

Thank you for participating in our capital campaign – 130 generous pledges resulted in a promising \$2.2 million toward the initial \$5.7 million plan to address needs for lobby space, adequate bathrooms, classrooms for Adult Sunday School and more worship space.

After assessing the gap between the funds pledged and the projected cost, a motion was made at Cornerstone's Annual Meeting, held Dec. 4th, that the best way forward is to direct the Building Committee to develop a new plan that meets our needs at a more cost-effective price point – That motion was unanimously approved. So beginning in January, our Building Committee will review our future needs and reconceptualize a revised plan – our goal is to have an updated design ready to review by the fall of 2026. Pray that the Holy Spirit will guide us to a new plan that will meet our needs in a financially responsible manner. Stay tuned in 2026 for a better plan at a better price point!



UPDATE FROM THE STAFF-PARISH RELATIONS COMMITTEE:

Pamela Carlson resigned effective November 25 from her part-time position as Coordinator of Cornerstone's Freedom in Christ Ministry and Coordinator of Hospitality. We thank God for the way in which Pamela built our Freedom in Christ Ministry, developed the Connection Point ministry, and effectively scheduled greeters, communion servers and prayer ministers. Bethany Severson has been hired in a part-time position to become the new Coordinator of Hospitality, scheduling greeters, communion servers and prayer ministers for Communion Sundays. Our goal is continue our Freedom in Christ Ministry and we will begin searching for a new Coordinator.

CORNERSTONE'S 2026 BUDGET:

Our Dec. 4th, 2025 Annual Meeting unanimously approved our \$1.9 million 2026 ministry budget which supports our 9 full-time staff, 13 part-time staff as they lead our local ministries, as well as enables us to support 6 local ministries (Access Ministry, Brothers and Sisters Behind Bars, Fall Out Shelter, Haven Center, Cornerstone Food Pantry, Watertown Christian School), 4 ministries in the US (Luke Smith with Canyon Pathways, Teen Challenge of the Dakotas, Intervarsity College Ministry, Re-Creation Center in Oglala, SD) and 14 missionaries scattered across the globe. Our 2026 budget is a 10% increase from 2025. Thank you for your glad and generous giving to the ministry Jesus has given us – and thank you for increasing your giving as the Lord increases your income. Looking forward to seeing how we will be able to welcome more kids, youth, and adults to find their spiritual home in Jesus in 2026!
